

**MINUTES OF THE JUNE 13, 2017  
MEETING OF THE ADVISORY COMMISSION ON AGING

Commissioner Labunski moved to approve the minutes of May 9, 2017. The minutes were seconded by Commissioner Rupkey and were unanimously approved.

**Old Business:**

Commissioner Marrazzo spoke about AT&T and how it did not pass legislators. AT&T did give the reasoning as to why they do not want landlines any longer. Representatives called Commissioner Rupkey and spoke about why it did not pass. Representative Silverstein stated Illinois will always have a landline.

Mr. Friel stated that 9-1-1 is evolving to NG 911 which allows streaming videos to first responders along with additional information which can be sent.

Mr. Friel spoke about senior transportation particularly about a senior using ride sharing. Ms. Philippart, Social Worker, and Ms. Paz, Mather LifeWays, worked with a senior so he could be able to use Uber or LIFT. Since that time, it has worked out great for the individual to get to his designated place. It was discussed about having a technology class just for ride sharing or shopping. In general, the technology classes will be placed in the newsletter.

### **New Business**

Kate Paz, Mather LifeWays, stated there is a Community Care Program which includes adult daycare, home meals, etc., however there are case managers which rate you to have your needs met. It is income eligible based on Federally funded money.

There are other companies which offer these types of services and have you pay on a sliding scale.

Trustee Thill stated the Village opted out of the Cook County Ordinance which stated in step increases, wages would increase up to \$15 per hour over the next few years.
