Advisory Commission on Aging – Provides a forum for the discussion of problems of the Village’s aging population and proposals to meet these needs, as well as to aid elders in presenting their viewpoint to the public and private agencies.

Meets: 1:00 pm on the second Tuesday of the month

Appearance Review Commission – Reviews applications for sign permits, site, landscape, and building plans in accordance with Village code.

Meets: 7:00 pm on the first Monday of the month

Cable and Telecommunications Commission – Provides a forum for the Village’s cable subscribers to discuss issues and concerns, and evaluate resident complaints on technical interference and administrative matters.

Meets: 7:30 pm twice a year

Community Relations Commission – Their purpose is to foster, encourage, and stimulate the improvement of relations ongoing and between citizens of all races, creeds, national origins, and economic and educational levels; and to provide all individuals with an equal opportunity to grow and participate in the economic, educational, social, and cultural activities available in our community. The commission will also assist in the development of public information and related communication programs to enhance the quality of life of residents.

Meets: 7:30 pm on the second Tuesday every other month

Economic Development Commission – Serves in an advisory capacity to the Village Board and examines policies and actions which impact the Village’s economic development. The commission makes recommendations which will promote economic development, retain and attract businesses, and achieve an effective balance between the needs of residents, businesses and the Village.

Meets: 5:30 pm on the third Wednesday of the month

Board of Environmental Health – Reviews and evaluates various environmental issues and public health matters and advises the Village Board and other interested parties of findings and recommendations.

Meets: 7:00 pm on the first Tuesday of the month

Board of Fire and Police Commissioners – Responsible for all sworn appointments in fire and police departments as designated by law through competitive entrance and promotional examination processes. The Board of Fire and Police Commissioners also have disciplinary powers concerning sworn police and fire department personnel as designated by law.

Meets: 7:00 pm on the fourth Tuesday of the month

Fire Pension Board – Responsible for the management of the Firefighter’s Pension Fund.

Meets: 3:00 pm third Tuesday every quarter

Natural Resources Commission – Serves in an advisory role and makes recommendations to the Village Board regarding the development of policies with respect to trees and other natural resources within the Village. Makes investigations and other recommendations to preserve, conserve, protect, and enhance the environment and natural resources of the community.

Meets: 6:00 pm meets third Monday of every other month

Plan Commission – Prepares and recommends to the Village Board a comprehensive plan of public goals and improvements to the present and future development of the Village. Provides review of development proposals and reasonable requirements in reference to land development and redevelopment. Reviews and makes recommendations to the Board on applications for special uses and planned unit developments and subdivisions.

Meets: 7:00 pm on the third Monday of the month

Police Pension Board – Responsible for the management of the Police Officer's Pension Fund.

Meets: 5:00 pm quarterly

Traffic Safety Commission – Reviews and presents recommendations to the Village Board regarding requests or inquiries on matters involving traffic safety including requests for installation of traffic control devices. Reviews and makes recommendations on all proposed developments brought before the Plan Commission.

Meets: 7:30 pm on the first Thursday of the month

Zoning Board of Appeals – Responsible for hearing and deciding upon appeals from any order, requirement, decision, or determination made by the Building Commissioner or other authorized officials having jurisdiction under the Municipal Code. Hears applications for variations from the Village's Unified Development Code.

Meets: 7:00 pm on the third Monday of the month
