

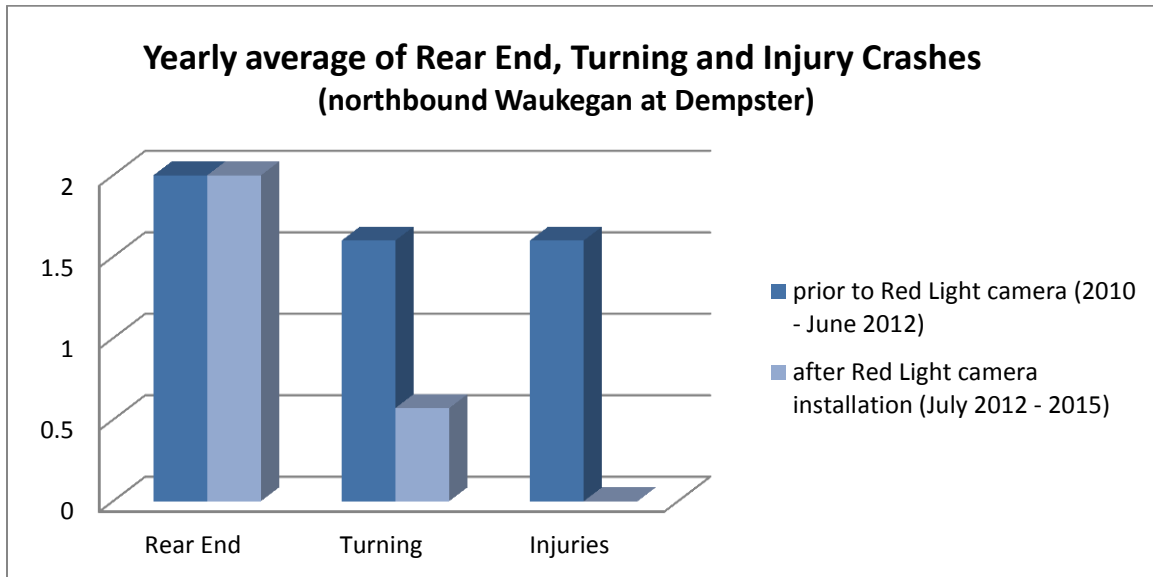
Since July 2012, The Village of Morton Grove has a Red Light camera at the intersection of Waukegan and Dempster, covering the northbound Waukegan traffic lanes. Specifically, the camera covers the two left turn lanes (to westbound Dempster) and the two straight lanes continuing north on Waukegan. *(The Red Light camera does not cover the right turn lane to eastbound Dempster.)*

The timing of the traffic signals is controlled and maintained by the Illinois Department of Transportation (I.D.O.T) and the Red Light camera is manufactured and maintained by:

On average there have been 212 red light citations issued per month. The Village of Morton Grove holds adjudication hearings approximately once per month at the Village Hall. Since the installation of the Red Light camera, there have been 348 persons scheduled over a total of 47 hearings for an average of 7.4 persons per hearing. However, many violators pay the fine prior to the hearing date.

The following data was collected from the Illinois Department of Transportation. *(Crash data for 2016 was not available from IDOT at the completion of this report.)*
