ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING

- plastic** bottles, jugs, and food-related jars & tubs
- glass** food-related jars & bottles
- metal** cans, foil, & pie pans
- paper** newspapers, magazines, mail, documents, cards, tubes, cardboard, bags, beverage cartons, & pizza boxes without food residue



Materials must be placed in cart loose, empty, and clean.



NOT ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING

- plastic** straws, bags, wrap, styrofoam, & cutlery
- glass** windows, mirrors, vases, cups, pottery, & bulbs
- paper** with food residue, tissues, towels, plates, cups, & shredded documents
- food & liquids
- electronics
- sharps
- diapers
- clothing & shoes
- hoses
- wire & hangers
