## Annual Vehicle Stickers Available for Purchase

Residents are reminded that Morton Grove vehicle stickers are now available for purchase online at [www.mortongroveil.org](http://www.mortongroveil.org) (Click "Services," "I Want To," "Vehicle Sticker") or by mail.

- Vehicle stickers are NOT available at Village Hall.
- 2021/22 stickers expire August 31, 2022. All vehicles registered to a Morton Grove address must have a 2022/23 sticker affixed to them by August 31, 2022.
- Vehicle stickers cost \$55 each for passenger vehicles. Seniors are eligible for a reduced rate of \$25 for passenger vehicles with a limit of one per household.

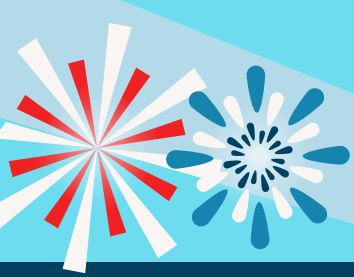

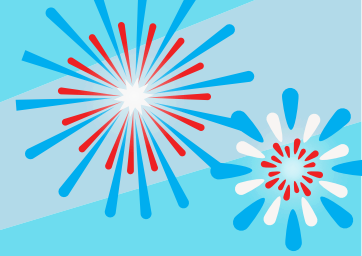
