Snow Removal Tips

- ✱ Avoid driving during a major snow event.
- ✱ Park vehicles in a garage or driveway to allow Public Works plows to clear snow to the curb.
- ✱ If you must park on the street, move your car to an area that is cleared of snow as soon as possible.
- ✱ Avoid parking on streets marked as a SNOW ROUTE during snow events.
- ✱ Be patient and considerate as snowfall events are commonplace in our region.
