Chef/Proprietor Robin Hoppenrath has been catering since the mid-1980's alongside Classy Cut's Nancy Watson. Robin purchased the catering business from Nancy in 2007, and in 2018 she decided to end the catering-only operation to launch take-away meal options at C'Mon Eat.

This take-out gem is tucked in the Austin/Dempster plaza in a former bakery at the northwest corner of Austin Avenue and Dempster Street. Parking is plentiful and the location is in the heart of Morton Grove. The business is a member of the Chamber of Commerce and has been a proud participant in The Taste of Morton Grove.

Robin runs a one-person business that prides itself with fresh food made daily that is locally sourced and shopped. Open Tuesday through Friday from 11:00 am to 6:00 pm, lunch and dinner options are plentiful for all types of eaters.

Vegan, gluten-free, and allergy considerations are all options. Grab soup, salads, sandwiches with fruit

and a dessert for lunch. Take home complete entrees for dinner, always available, and even guaranteed hot for instant dinner from 4:30-6:00 pm. Each day, dinner options include fish, chicken, beef and vegan. They are portioned in individual containers along with two side dishes, usually a starch and a vegetable. Try salmon with orange salsa, vegan patty with sweet potatoes, turkey korma, or even good old fashioned meatloaf.

The freezer is packed with soups, complete meals and even Robin's famous hors d'oeuvres for your next party.

As the website notes, "You can Eat Now, Eat Later, or Eat Whenever at C'Mon Eat".

When asked about specialties, Robin was quick to say that she loves cooking, creating and making sure that her hand-crafted soups and stews are there to please. Robin also maintains her catering role, as the demand for servicing the hosts of small parties is always increasing.
