

MINUTES OF THE JUNE 2, 2026 SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
BOARD OF FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSIONERS
OF THE VILLAGE OF MORTON GROVE

Pursuant to proper notice in accordance with the Open Meetings Act, the special meeting of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners was called to order at 1:00 p.m. Those in attendance were:

This Special meeting was called for the purpose of conducting a final oral interview on a Fire Department candidate. Prior to the interview, Chief Weitzel confirmed that the Board will be interviewing five Police Officers at the next regular meeting. It was decided to allow 20 minutes for each interview, commencing at 1:00 p.m.

Chief Kennedy presented a list of candidates from the Fire Department Eligibility List, numbering 17 through 34, who have been contacted and have responded that they wish to be removed from the list, due to being hired elsewhere, or just not interested any more.

At 1:05 p.m., Chief Weitzel and Secretary LeBeau left the meeting and Fire Candidate #35 Sean Eder was brought in for his final oral interview. At the completion of the interview, Mr. Eder was asked to step out, while the board deliberated. After a brief discussion, Commissioner Hofeld moved to give the candidate a conditional offer of employment, pending the successful completion of all remaining tests. Commissioner Rubio seconded, and the motion passed with a unanimous voice vote. Mr. Eder was brought back to the meeting, where he was informed of the decision, and he accepted the offer of employment.

There being no further business, Commissioner Hofeld moved to adjourn the meeting at 1:20 p.m. Commissioner Rubio seconded, and all approved with a voice vote.
