AMAZON FRESH ANNOUNCES GRAND OPENING IN MORTON GROVE

Amazon announced that Amazon Fresh at Sawmill Station, located at the southeast corner of Waukegan Road and Dempster Street in Morton Grove, Illinois, will open its doors to the public for in-store shopping beginning Thursday, November 11, at 7:00 a.m. Earlier this year, the new 35,000-square-foot grocery store was revealed to be one of a handful of new Amazon Fresh stores in the Chicagoland area. This is Amazon Fresh's fifth store to open in Illinois.

A grocery store was part of original approved plans for the 26-acre Sawmill Station mixed-use lifestyle center, which is already home to Kohl's, Cooper's Hawk, Raising Cane's, Starbucks, Chipotle, Ross, Dollar Tree, and a nearly completed 250-unit residential apartment building. Staff and elected officials worked closely with the site developer, IM Kensington MG LLC, to follow through on a promise to the community to make a full-service grocery store part of the overall development.

Mayor Daniel P. DiMaria stated, "The Village and residents are excited to welcome Amazon Fresh to Morton Grove. We are looking forward to a long and successful partnership with Amazon. My hope is that residents will enjoy this new kind of shopping experience. This high-tech store shows just how progressive Morton Grove has become. This store has been a long time coming, and the time has finally arrived. Morton Grove and Amazon Fresh are open for business."

According to Amazon, the new Amazon Fresh store has been designed to offer a seamless grocery shopping experience, whether customers are shopping in-store or online. Amazon Fresh offers Just Walk Out shopping, which allows customers to scan in, shop, and walk out. No Amazon membership is required. The store will offer all the features of a traditional full-service grocery store, plus in-store pickups and returns of Amazon packages.

Amazon Fresh in Morton Grove is located at 6939 Dempster Street and will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., seven days per week.
