NEW BUSINESS

PC14-14 - Virtuoso Performing Arts - 8120 Lehigh Ave (North Grove Corporate Park): Request for a special use permit to operate entertainment use.

Amanda Larson, a representative of Virtuoso Performing Arts, addressed the Commission stating that the hours of operation are Monday - Friday, 3:30-9:30 p.m. The facility would put on a total of 4-5 performances throughout the year.

Commissioner Rockel asked how snow removal and refuse storage would be handled.

Nancy Radzevich stated that the business is part of a large scale development run by Colliers and all of these issues would be handled by management.

Commissioner Karagozian asked if the Fire Department could foresee any issues.

Captain Porter noted that the parking lot was designed for maneuverability of emergency vehicles and that the management company had always maintained superior access.

Ms. Larson then shared the results of a traffic study which found that the business will not affect the normal flow of traffic in the area as operation occurs during off times of regular business.

Chairman White asked if there were any anticipated issues in relation to the Metra.

Ms. Larson states that none were anticipated.

Commissioner Rockel then moved to approve the special use permit for Virtuoso Performing Arts.
